## The 3<sup>rd</sup> Twin2Go newsletter

Twin2Go's third issue of its newsletter "*Synthesising research for adaptive water governance*" was distributed in month nineteen of the project. The newsletter was sent out to the project partners, the project Advisory Board, to the members of related twinning projects, to related initiatives, to related water management projects, and to all individuals who previously subscribed to the newsletter.

The four-page newsletter includes the following categories:

- **Introduction**
  - This third issue begins with some preliminary insights from the comparative analysis on water governance. Three different analysis methods are presented, which were used on the 29 basin case study dataset.
- **News**
  - This section reviews the Synthesis Workshop, which took place in September 2010, and at which the three above-mentioned analysis methods were discussed with project partners, Advisory Board members, and interested external parties.
- **Upcoming activities**
  - Upcoming Regional Best Practice Workshops – to take place during December 2010-February 2011 – are presented. A map showing the locations of these workshops is included.
  - Upcoming Policy Workshops – to take place during April-September 2011 – are announced.
- **Related initiatives**
  - Two comparative papers published online are announced, whose topic is 'pursuing adaptiveness in water management'. Both articles were completed under the acknowledged influence of Twin2Go.
  - A brief report on the guidance document produced and adopted by the Parties to the UNECE / WHO-EURO Protocol on Water and Health is included.
  - The Global Catchment Initiative Conference 2010 – *The Global Dimensions of Change in River Basins – Threats, Linkages and Adaptation* – and a Twin2Go workshop taking place within the scope of this conference are announced.
